# LONE STAR QUARTER HORSE ASSOCIATION HIGH POINT/YEAR END AWARD RULES

1. All AQHA rules and regulations apply except as noted.
2. Membership and award eligibility for LSQHA is effective when membership dues are paid and horse is nominated. (For Point standings, contact Janice Clevenger at 972-782-8773.)
3. Show year runs from January 1 thru December 31 of calendar year.
4. LSQHA approved shows are listed below. These dates are tentative and are subject to change.
5. Horses must be owned by LSQHA members.
6. Points are awarded toward a specific class and are not transferable between classes except in the case of a stallion being gelded. The points accumulated by the stallion go with him as a gelding.
7. Points awarded in combined classes are applicable toward the appropriate class standing.
8. Corrections in point standings are the responsibility of the horse owner and must be directed toward the LSQHA representative responsible for recording the points within two weeks of publication.
9. Points shall be awarded on the following basis to be qualified.

10. Five Shows/Ten points rule
  - A. Must PLACE in a minimum of 5 shows and accumulate 10 points to qualify for year-end awards.
  - B. In classes not offered at each show (i.e., Cutting, in which case the horse must place in 50% of the classes offered and receive a minimum of 1 point for each class offered).
11. Awards shall be presented as follows: Awards will be given only if there are three or more in the class.
  - A. OPEN AWARDS shall be presented in all events with qualifying horses and to the OPEN HIGH POINT HORSE.
  - B. AMATEUR AWARDS shall be presented in all events with qualifying horses and to the AMATEUR HIGH POINT HORSE AND RIDER.
  - C. NOVICE AWARDS shall be presented in all events with qualifying horses and to the HIGH POINT NOVICE HORSE AND RIDER.
  - D. SELECT AWARDS shall be presented in all events with qualifying horses and to the SELECT HIGH POINT HORSE AND RIDER.
  - E. AMATEUR & YOUTH ROOKIE OF THE YEAR AWARD.
  - F. YOUTH AWARDS:
 

13 & UNDER, NOVICE, and 14 thru18 AWARDS shall be presented in all events with qualifying horses and to the HIGH POINT HORSE AND RIDER. YOUTH WINNERS OF MORE THAN ONE EVENT WILL ONLY RECEIVE A COMBINED AWARD.
12. In the event of a tie, both horses will be presented an award.
